Jason Welty Joins CCOC as Budget and Communications Director

Tallahassee, Fla. — Jason Welty joins the Florida Clerks of Court Operations Corporation (CCOC) today as budget and communications director. He is responsible for designing, developing and communicating a budget that reasonably and adequately funds Florida's clerks of court in the performance of their court-related functions. He will also serve as the lead staff for the CCOC budget and legislative committees.

"Jason's experience in both budgeting and the legislature will help clerks to continue to strengthen and improve our budget process, and communicate the costs of the core services we provide to our state partners. We are ecstatic to have him as part of our team," said the Honorable Stacy Butterfield, CCOC Executive Council Chair and Polk County Clerk of Court.

Welty brings extensive budget, communications and legislative experience to the CCOC, with more than 13 years of government service in Florida. He served most recently as the senior budget analyst for the House Justice Appropriations Committee. Previously, he worked as legislative affairs director and chief of staff at the Florida Department of Juvenile Justice, senior legislative aide to Senator Rob Bradley, and as policy chief in the Governor's Office of Policy and Budget. Welty holds a bachelor's degree in political science and a master's degree in public affairs.

Welty replaces Jason Harrell, who will remain with CCOC until the conclusion of the Revenue Estimating Conference on July 18, 2018. Harrell has been named director of legislative and government affairs for the Florida Court Clerks & Comptrollers.
