## AGENDA ITEM 3

DATE:May 3, 2022SUBJECT:Timeliness

## **OVERVIEW:**

The PIE Committee previously reviewed making adjustments to Timeliness standards using data from CFY 2016-17. Six pilot counties were used to tracking the number of days and the total cases processed by day. The previous workgroup recommended changing the standard from 80% to 90% and reducing the number of days by 1. The summary for Time 1 – Filing New Cases and Time 2 – Docketing Cases is attached.

A summary of the reason for failing to meet the standard for CFY 2020-21 is also attached.

The workgroup will need to discuss:

- If they want to re-do the pilot with new counties
- The impact of changing the days to process on systems
- The impact of changing the percentage on systems and counties who would now fail to meet the standard
- If this standard for these court divisions is relevant of if the standard should be something new.
