



## BUDGET PROCESS HIGHLIGHTS

<u>June</u> – Budget issue requests due on June 1<sup>st</sup>

<u>July/August</u> – Article V Revenue Estimating Conference (REC) meets to set the available revenue for the year

State Funding – appropriated from the Legislature:

- Jury Reimbursement Funding \$ 11.7 million
  - State General Revenue funds
  - Released quarterly on the State Fiscal Year



# LEGISLATIVE BUDGET-RELATED HIGHLIGHTS

- Continued state jury funding of \$11.7 million
- Employer portion of FRS increases of \$164,000 (substantially less than \$5.4 million last year)
- Nine New Judges Approved
  - Seven County Judges
  - Two Circuit Judges
