STATEMENT FOUND ON WEBSITE

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The Florida Guardianship Database Transparency (FLGDT) System is a statewide database of guardian and guardianship case information that aims to facilitate improving court oversight of guardianship cases while also providing transparency to the public. Guardian information and data regarding individual guardians registered with the Florida Department of Elder Affairs' (DOEA) Office of Public and Professional Guardians (OPPG) is provided by OPPG. Questions, concerns, and requests for information regarding registered guardians and guardian data contained within the FLDGT should be directed to the OPPG. Office of Public & Professional Guardians (OPPG) - DOEA (elderaffairs.org). Guardianship case information is provided by the Florida's Clerks and Comptrollers Association (FLCCC), Comprehensive Case Information System (CCIS). Case information is reported to CCIS by Florida's counties Clerks of Court. Questions, concerns, and requests for information regarding guardianship case information contained within the FLGDT should be directed to the county Clerk of Court where the case resides. Temporarily – FLCCOC is providing access to the Judicial website until the "Gatekeeper" process is fully implemented



LEGISLATION Para (1) – FLCCOC & Clerks

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Title XLIII DOMESTIC RELATIONS GUARDIANSHIP

Chapter 744

View Entire Chapter

744.2112 Guardianship information and transparency.-

(1)The Florida Clerks of Court Operations Corporation and the clerks of court shall establish a statewide database of guardian and guardianship case information to facilitate improving court oversight of guardianship cases. The database may not be operational for end users until on or after July 1, 2023. The database must meet interoperability standards defined by the Florida Courts Technology Commission so that each circuit court can easily access the information for regular use in judicial proceedings under this chapter. The database must include, at a minimum, the following:

- The registration status of each professional guardian. (a)
- The substantiated disciplinary history of each professional guardian. (b)

The status of each guardian's compliance with the statutory gualifications for guardianship (c) under s. 744.2003 or s. 744.3145.

The status of statutorily required reports and submissions under this chapter. (d)

- Department of Elderly Affairs (DEA) / Office of Public and Professional Guardians (OPPG)
 – as required by 744.2112(4)
- OPPG as required by 744.2112(4)

- OPPG as part of the data supplied to meet 744.2112(1)(a) requirement
- County Clerks' offices reporting through individual Court Management Systems (CMS) to the Comprehensive Case Information System (CCIS) offered by the Florida Court Clerks and Comptrollers Association (FCCC)



LEGISLATION PARA (1) – Clerks' Data

- FCCC Guardianship Information Transparency Operations Workgroup (FCCC-GIT OW) established a business practice for **nine required elements** as follows:
 - 1. The location of the guardians' office
 - 2. The name of the petitioner
 - 3. The name of the ward
 - 4. The name of the professional guardian
 - 5. Legal counsel for all parties (petitioner, ward, guardian)
 - 6. Demographic information for the ward
 - 7. The name of the judge assigned to each professional guardianship case
 - 8. The circuit in which the case is brought
 - 9. The ward's county of residence
- The workgroup determined the **nine specific elements** could be captured using information already available to clerks and their CMS's from information found in the petition and other orders as part of the normal function and flow of the guardianship process
- The workgroup determined that **three of the remaining elements** could be captured by creating and using the party name/type function within the CMS
 - 1. Identifying Professional guardianship cases and eliminating the incorrect reporting of Non-Professional guardianship cases
 - 2. Identifying whether the guardianship is Limited or Plenary
 - 3. Identifying whether the guardianship case is truly Active or Terminated
- The workgroup also determined the status of statutorily required reports and submissions could be captured using "non-imaged" events, known as docket entries.



LEGISLATION Para (2) – Secured Database

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(2)(a) Except as provided under paragraph (3)(b), the database shall be accessible only by members of the judiciary, their direct staff, and court personnel and clerks of court personnel authorized by a judge to assist with guardianship matters. The database must restrict access to the information necessary to perform such individuals' duties but in no way restrict access by judges or magistrates.

(b) The database must be searchable by, at a minimum, the name of the petitioner, ward, guardian, and legal counsel for all parties; the demographic information of the ward; the location of the guardian's office; the name of the judge and the circuit in which the case is brought; and the number of wards served by each guardian, by ward county of residence.



LEGISLATION Para (2) – Data Source Party

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Statutorily required searchable Database Elements in para (2)(b)

- the 1) name of the petitioner, 2) ward, 3) guardian, and 4) legal counsel for all parties
- the demographic information of the ward
- the location of the guardian's office
- the name of the judge and the circuit in which the case is brought
- number of wards served by each guardian, by ward county of residence







FLCCOC's Current Status

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The Databases, FLGDT – Judicial and FLGDT – Public, website applications went live in April 2024 as a soft launch (un-publicized)

Case Management System updates were fielded to incorporate new Party-Type codes and Report Event codes

Currently, 52 Clerk offices are using the additional "Party-Type" codes developed to bring three additional statutorily required data elements for Guardianship into CCIS



LEGISLATION Para (4) – DEA/OPPG

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(4) The Office of Public and Professional Guardians is directed to share professional guardian registration and disciplinary action information for the purposes of this section.

LEGISLATION Para (5) – OPPAGA

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- (5)(a) Beginning July 1, 2024, and annually thereafter through July 1, 2027, the Florida Clerks of Court Operations Corporation must compile and report data collected by the clerks of court and the Department of Elderly Affairs and maintained in the database to the Office of Program Policy Analysis and Government Accountability (OPPAGA).
- (b) OPPAGA must analyze the consolidated data compiled in accordance with paragraph (a) to evaluate trends in the use of guardianships in this state and to conduct a comparative analysis of guardianship laws in other states. OPPAGA must consult with the Office of the State Courts Administrator, the Florida Clerks of Court Operations Corporation, the clerks of court, and the Department of Elderly Affairs during its analysis. OPPAGA shall submit a report containing its findings and recommendations to the Governor, the President of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives by October 15, 2024, and annually thereafter through October 15, 2027.



FLCCOC's Current Status With OPPAGA

- •OPPAGA requested access to the Judicial website in July to fulfill the statutory requirements of s.744.2112(5)(a) and (b)
- •Started analyzing the data available from websites as required in s.744.2112(5)(b)
- •Will provide feedback to FLCCOC to develop the actual report elements needed to fulfill the statutory requirements of s.744.2112(5)(a)
- Provided Report to Governor and Legislature on October 15th, 2024. <u>https://oppaga.fl.gov/Products/ReportDetail?rn=24-07</u>




FLGDT FUTURE "IT WILL GET BETTER"
