

CCOC Education Committee – Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)



1. What is the role of the Education Committee?

The Education Committee supports the professional development of Florida's Clerks of Court by identifying and promoting training opportunities that enhance consistency, efficiency, and compliance with statewide standards.

2. Who serves on the Education Committee?

The committee is made up of Clerks of Court and their staff, appointed by the CCOC Chair. CCOC staff also participate to help coordinate training activities and provide support.

3. What does the Education Committee do?

The committee works to:

- Identify training needs across Clerk offices
- Develop and review education and training resources
- Coordinate workshops, webinars, and conference sessions
- Encourage best practices and knowledge sharing statewide
- Support ongoing professional growth for Clerk staff

4. How are training priorities decided?

Training priorities are based on feedback from Clerks and staff, survey results, legislative or procedural changes, and statewide performance trends.

5. What types of training does the committee help provide?

The committee supports a variety of training opportunities, including:

- In-person and virtual workshops
- Webinars and online learning modules
- New Clerk and staff orientation
- Topic-specific sessions on budgeting, reporting, performance measures, court related topics

6. How can I suggest a new training topic?

7. Does the committee organize sessions at Clerk conferences?

Yes. The Education Committee assists in planning and coordinating educational sessions at CCOC and statewide Clerk events.

8. How often does the Education Committee meet?

The committee meets several times a year, typically in coordination with CCOC meetings or upcoming training initiatives. Meeting dates and materials are posted on the CCOC website.
